PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

- Summertime has brought a rise to larcenies! Only carry what you need and keep your valuables secured.
 - PRO TIP: Don't leave anything of value outside your residence/vehicle/etc., or easily seen inside residence/vehicle/etc.
- Auto Break-ins are still ongoing.
 - **CRIME & INTELLIGENCE ANALYST NOTE TO THE PUBLIC:**
 - Favorite stolen item is Car Titles that allows suspect to use victim's car in their name or to use victim's information to secure fraudulent loans or other loans using the vehicle as collateral
 - Vehicle Registration: using the vehicle's VIN, suspect secures or forges duplicate titles
 - Cloned titles and VINs are currently being investigated all over USA that are linked back to Auto Break-ins

The Charleston County Sheriff's Office is accepting applications for its next Citizens Academy. The 11-week course will highlight different functions of our law enforcement agency, giving people a better understanding of the tasks employees perform to protect and serve Charleston County residents.
