§4.1.10 Permit Requirements for Water and Wastewater Systems

§4.1.11 No person may build, construct, alter or install any water or wastewater system ("system") which has a potential to contaminate drinking water without first obtaining a permit from the Town of Seabrook Island Utility Commission (SIUC). A system shall include, but not be limited to irrigation devices, pools, fountains and fire sprinkler devices. Permits to construct a proposed system shall be issued subject to the following:

- (a) The system conforms to the Standard Plumbing Code as amended and adopted under Charleston County Ordinance No. 1190, as amended, together with any future amendments of the Standard Plumbing Code;
- (b) The system meets all requirements of the SIUC; and
- (c) The system and all construction relating to it are in compliance with applicable ordinances, rules and regulations of the Town.

§4.1.12 No person may operate any system until fulfillment of the following:

- (a) The system has been inspected and successfully tested by a DHEC approved qualified tester;
- (b) A copy of the DHEC certified tester's report has been received by the SIUC; and
- (c) All other applicable laws, rules and regulations have been satisfied. (Ordinance 1997-13, 12/30/97; amended Ordinance 2000-02, 3/28/00)

§4.1.20 Sewage Disposal Systems Allowed

Only public or private central sewer systems meeting the requirements of the South

Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SC DHEC) are authorized within the Town of Seabrook Island. No individual subsurface sewage disposal systems are authorized within the Town of Seabrook Island.

§4.1.20 Drought Response Policy Adopted

The Seabrook Island utility Commission's Drought Response Policy, dated April 16, 2003, attached to Ordinance 2003-06 as adopted, is hereby incorporated in this Ordinance by reference. Failure of any person, persons, company, or other entity to abide by the terms of the Drought Response Policy shall constitute a violation of the Town Code and shall subject the violator to criminal penalties in amounts as set forth in the policy. All such violations may be enforced in the municipal court of the Town of Seabrook Island. (Ordinance 2003-06, 10/28/03)

§4.3.10 Telephone Franchise Agreement Adopted

The Franchise Agreement between the Town of Seabrook Island and Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, effective as of September 1, 1987, a copy of which was attached as "Exhibit A" to Ordinance 87-13 upon adoption and incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein, is hereby adopted by the Town of Seabrook Island. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign said Agreement and all documents relating thereto. (Ordinance 87-13, 12/10/87); Ordinance 2004-03, 8/24/04)

§4.3.20 Electric Service Franchise Agreement Adopted

The Franchise Agreement between the Town of Seabrook Island and Berkeley Electric Cooperative, Inc., a copy of which was attached as "Attachment A" to Ordinance 88-4 upon adoption and incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein, is hereby adopted by the Town of Seabrook Island. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign said Agreement and all documents relating thereto. (Ordinance 88-4, 2/11/88; Ordinance 2004-03, 8/24/04)

§4.3.30 Cable Television Franchise Agreement Adopted

The cable television agreement attached as "Exhibit A" to Ordinance 1999-02 upon adoption and incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein by reference is hereby adopted. (Ordinance 1999-02, 2/24/99; Ordinance 2004-03, 8/24/04)
