**§7.1.10 Business License Ordinance Adopted.**

The "Town of Seabrook Island Business License Ordinance", as amended, which was originally attached as "Exhibit "A" to Ordinance 1993-04 upon adoption and incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein, is hereby adopted. (Ordinance 1993-04, 8/12/93; amended Ordinance 1993-07, 10/14/93; Ordinance 1994-12, 1/12/95; Ordinance 1995-03, 4/13/95; Ordinance 1995-19, 1/11/96; Ordinance 1997-05, 4/22/97; Ordinance 1998-05, 3/24/98; Ordinance 1998-11, 6/23/98; Ordinance 1999-06, 9/28/99; Ordinance 1999-07, 10/26/99; Ordinance 1999-11, 11/23/99; Ordinance 2004-03, 8/24/04)

**§7.1.20 License Required**

It shall be a violation of this Ordinance for any contractor, subcontractor or other person or entity to use the services of any other contractor, subcontractor, person or company who does not have a valid business license issued by the Town of Seabrook Island. (Ordinance 2004-0005, 6/22/04)

**§7.1.30 Fees**

The Town shall charge a fee for the issuance of business licenses beginning in fiscal year 1990 and continuing annually thereafter. The fee schedule, originally adopted by Town Council and subsequently amended, shall be applied. (Ordinance 1989-06, 12/14/89; amended Ordinance 1994-12, 1/12/95; Ordinance 1995-03, 4/13/95; Ordinance 1998-05, 3/24/98; Ordinance 1998-11, 6/23/98); Ordinance 2004-03, 8/24/04)

**§7.2.10 Creation of an Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee**

There is hereby created an Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee for the Town of Seabrook Island. (Ordinance 87-12, 10/8/87)

**§7.2.20 Membership**

**§7.2.21** The Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee shall be composed of seven (7) members. Four (4) members shall be employees of, have a financial interest in, or otherwise represent the hospitality industry of the Town. One member shall represent the cultural organizations of the Town.

**§7.2.22** Members shall be appointed by Town Council and shall serve for a term of two (2) years; provided that upon the creation of a vacancy on the Committee, the replacement member shall fill the unexpired term of the member he has replaced. All terms shall end on the 31st day of December of the appropriate year. (Ordinance 87-12, 10/8/87; amended Ordinance 1989-09, 12/10/89)

**§7.2.30 Powers and Duties**

**§7.2.31** The Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee shall be an advisory committee to Town Council, and shall make recommendations to Town Council concerning the expenditure of revenues received by the Town which have been generated from the accommodations tax, consistent with the requirements of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended.

**§7.2.32** The Committee shall elect a chairman and secretary from its membership, shall make such rules as are necessary to perform its designated function, shall advertise its meetings by placing a notice on the official Town bulletin board at least seven (7) days prior to each meeting, shall keep minutes of all meetings, and shall meet as often as necessary to perform its designated function, but no less than once per year.

**§7.2.33** Upon request by Town Council, the Committee shall meet to consider and make recommendations concerning any matter within its purview, as set forth above. (Ordinance 87-12, 10/8/87)

**§7.2.40 Compensation**

Members will serve without compensation. (Ordinance 87-12, 10/8/87)
