**§8.1.10 Adoption of State Law regulating traffic**

Unless otherwise specifically covered by this chapter, all of the provisions and requirements of the general law of the state regulating traffic on highways as contained in Title 56, Chapter 5 of the Code of Laws, 1976, as now in force or as hereafter amended and insofar as such provisions can have application within the Town, are adopted and made a part of this chapter as fully as though set out therein. All persons within the Town shall strictly comply with all of the regulations imposed hereby, when so applicable. (Ordinance 87-1, 10/15/87)

**§8.1.20 Enforcement**

The Town of Seabrook Island shall administer and enforce the provisions of this chapter directly and/or by contract with Charleston County. Violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall be a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine and/or other penalty as authorized in Section 1.3D.90 of the Town Code. (Ordinance 87-1, 10/15/87)

**§8.2.10 Prohibited Practices**

No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon any public roadway, street or shoulder within the Town limits. Furthermore, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle upon that portion of a public street or road between the curb line or the lateral lines of a roadway and the adjacent property lines. (Ordinance 1996-04, 5/9/96)

**§8.2.20 Liability for Vehicle Owner**

No person shall allow or permit any vehicle registered in his name to be parked or left standing in the Town in violation of any provision of this chapter or any other ordinance regulating the standing or parking of vehicles. (Ordinance 1996-04, 5/9/96)

**§8.2.30 Removal of Illegally Stopped Vehicles**

Whenever any public safety officer or the Code Enforcement Officer finds a vehicle standing upon a street or road in violation of any of the provisions of this Code, such officer is authorized to move such vehicle or require the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle to move the same to a position off the paved or main traveled part of such street. Whenever any public safety officer or the Code Enforcement Officer finds a vehicle unattended upon any public street or public parking area where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction of traffic or a threat to safety, such officer is authorized to provide for the removal of such vehicle to the nearest garage or other place of safety, and the owner of such vehicle shall pay all charges incidental to the removal and storage of such vehicle prior to the surrender of the vehicle to the owner. (Ordinance 1996-04, 5/9/96)

**§8.2.40 Issuance of municipal summons**

The Code Enforcement Officer for the Town of Seabrook Island or any public safety officer is authorized to issue a municipal summons in accordance with the provisions of Seabrook Island Town Code §9.1.10 for all violations of this chapter. (Ordinance 1996-04, 5/9/96)
