### PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

- **PRACTICE SUMMER HEAT SAFETY**
  - Never leave infant or young child alone in a closed car, EVER. Especially in the summer. Closed cars heats up as much as 20 degrees in 10 minutes!
  - Keep Kids Hydrated
  - Monitor Seniors' Medications – older people or people with heart conditions, diabetes and other health issues need to be extra careful about the heat
- **STAY SAFE AROUND WATER**
  - Never let a child near water unattended
  - Always wear a life jacket in a boat
- **PROTECT YOUR SKIN AGAINST SUNBURN**
  - Put on sunscreen every hour or two due to sweat and water washing it away. Sunburns makes you more vulnerable to skin cancer later on in life. A typical sunburn is a first-degree burn, and if it blisters, it is a second-degree burn.
  - To treat sunburns, wait for the sunburn to heal and avoid a second burn. Use moisturizers with or without aloe vera to sooth the burn. Avoid creams with topical antihistamines since they may lead to an allergic reaction to the patient
