OPERATING CONDITIONS (OPCON)

Operating Conditions (OPCON) define the current status of the Town on a scale of 1 (emergency) to 3 (normal). Each OPCON designates a set of conditions to define the operational status of the town and may also designate specific response actions for certain emergencies or disasters.

OPCON 3	Normal day-to-day operations
OPCON 2	Likely disaster impacts; preparations in place for cessation of normal government operations and activation of Municipal Emergency Operations Center (MEOC)
OPCON 1	Disaster or emergency imminent or occurring; full emergency response operations in effect
