CALL TO ORDER

Chair Councilwoman Fox called the meeting to order at 1:03 PM. Ms. Watkins confirmed that the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act were fulfilled, and the meeting agenda was properly posted.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Ms. Fox reviewed the minutes. As there was no discussion, Mr. Phillips made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting of June 16, 2022, which was seconded by Ms. Convers. The motion for APPROVAL was unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS ITEMS

1. Charleston Symphony Orchestra on Seabrook Island - Sunday, October 16

Roger Steele has volunteered to facilitate the plans for the Charleston Symphony Orchestra performance that will be held at the Lake House, beginning at 4:00 on Sunday, October 16. He has been in contact with Yuriy Bekker, Principal Pops Conductor, and submitted to Ms. Fox concert details and logistics which she shared with the committee.

2. Events for 2023 - Budget Requests

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding 2023 budget requests for consideration by the Town Council in their upcoming budget discussions. The following items were proposed to be presented to the Town Council for consideration.

- Continue the Community Promotion Grants Program at the current funding level of \$7,500.
- Continued support for current and future tourism and residential related events including Chow Town Food Truck Rodeo, December Holiday event, Town of Seabrook Incorporation event (new), and Disaster Awareness Day

- A motion moved by Mr. Phillips requests that the Town of Seabrook Council be advised that the Community Promotions and Engagement Committee supports the hiring of a public communications and event manager. The motion was seconded by Ms. Carter and unanimously APPROVED.
- A motion moved by Ms. Conyers requests that the Town of Seabrook Council
 consider engaging in a process to create a vision statement for the Town of Seabrook
 to identify the unique qualities of Seabrook Island. The motion was seconded by Ms.
 Carter and unanimously APPROVED.

ITEMS FOR INFORMATION / DISCUSSION

1. Update Chow Town Food Truck Rodeo

The first three Chow Town events have been well received and ideas were discussed regarding strategies for improvement including:

- providing shade options
- advising the food trucks to prepare for more non-alcoholic beverages
- adding more events and venue options for 2023

2. August 18 Regular Scheduled Meeting

The regularly scheduled meeting for August 18 was cancelled.

There being no further business, Mr. Phillips made a motion to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Mr. Carter. The motion was APPROVED unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 PM. The next meeting will be at the Town Hall on September 15, 2022 at 1:00.


