PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

MERRY CHRISTMAS

Jingle Bells! Jingle Bells! Jingle all the way! Oh, what fun, it to have a safe and jolly day!

Christmas time is here, along with many other end-of-the-year holidays! Here, at the Charleston County Sheriff's Office, we, too, are preparing for the holidays by keeping everyone protected and safe the best we can while patrolling your area, during those festive times. Make sure you wave hello if you see us passing by!

Just to let you know, vehicle break-ins have been on the rise, where perpetrators have broken car windows to get the items they see inside the car. Please do not leave any valuables, especially Christmas presents, easily visible through your var window. Remove those valuables from your vehicle, or put them in the trunk.

We would like to give our tips on ways you can also keep safe while preparing for, and during, these joyous holidays:

- Manage your Christmas tree. If it's real, make sure the stand is filled with water and doesn't dry out, posing an increased fire hazard. If artificial, make sure it's made from fire-resistant material
- **Keep flames away.** Don't leave children alone with lighted candles, matches, fireplaces, or any other sources of flame or heat.
- Watch for tempting seasonal décor. Keep decorations out of reach of children and secured to the wall. Any small object that can fit through a toilet paper roll can obstruct a child's airway.
- Keep plants out of little hands. Keep mistletoe, holly berries and poinsettias out of reach of children, as each is toxic when ingested.
- Remember electric safety. Use power strips with built-in circuit breakers. • Avoid putting too many plugs in one electrical outlet.
- Find safe toys. Make sure your children's toys are age appropriate and • the batteries cannot be easily removed.
- Monitor alcohol at home. Keep alcohol out of reach of children. • Quickly clean up leftover drinks.
- Bundle up and use safety gear. Dress properly for weather, making • sure that their hands, feet, and heads are covered.
