What's your New Years Resolution?

Lots of fireworks may still be going off, even though the New Years Celebration has ended. **Remember, the State of South Carolina has updated their fireworks law for 2024!**

UPDATE: Fireworks are still legal to buy and shoot in South Carolina, but, various rules and regulations have changed depending on the city, county, or municipality. On July 4th and New Year's Eve holidays, you can shoot fireworks until 1 AM the following day (July 4th and January 1st).

Buying and setting off fireworks in the City of Charleston and most of the area island is **ILLEGAL**; however, you can use sparklers. There are no laws set in unincorporated Charleston County. Please be aware of your residing area of Charleston County and follow the corresponding fireworks laws.

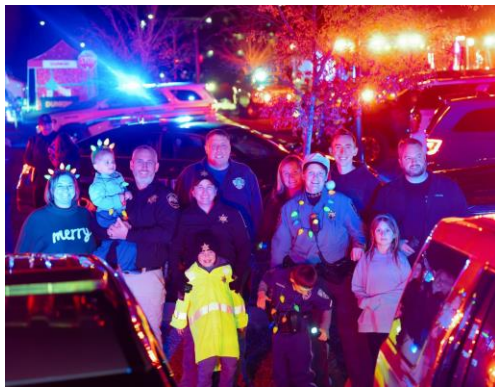
