PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

It's spring! And pollen is currently at an all time high!

Allergies are running rampant and it's time to **nip them in the bud** with the following tips:

Reduce your allergy exposure triggers

- Stay indoors on dry, windy days. The best time to go outside is after a good rain, which helps clear pollen from the air
- Avoid lawn mowing, weed pulling, and other gardening chores that stir up allergens
- Remove clothes you've worn outside and shower to rinse pollen from your skin and hair
- Don't hang laundry outside – pollen can stick to sheets and towels
- Wear a face mask if you do outside chores

Take extra steps when pollen counts are high

- Check your local TV or radio station, your local newspaper, or internet for pollen forecasts and current pollen levels
- If high pollen counts are forecasted, start taking allergy medications before your symptoms start
- Close doors and windows at night if possible or any other time when pollen counts are high
- Avoid outdoor activity in the early morning when pollen counts are highest

Keep indoor clean

- Use air conditioning in your house and car
- If you have forced air heating or air conditioning in your house, use high-efficiency filters and follow regular maintenance schedules
- Keep indoor air dry with a dehumidifier
- Use a portable high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filter in your bedroom
- Clean floors often with a vacuum cleaner that has a HEPA filter

Try an over-the-counter remedy

- Oral antihistamines
- Corticosteroid nasal sprays
- Cromolyn sodium nasal spray
- Oral decongestants
