PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

April is National Youth Sports Safety Month! Charleston County Sheriff's Office cares a lot about the youth! We don't just teach them about "See something, say something", and staying away from drugs, but we want to make sure they stay healthy and safe from injuries while they play their sports in this spring season.

Injury Reduction and Prevention

Injuries are the enemy of participation! Good news, though! According to the CDC (Centers of Disease Control and Prevention) stated that more than 50% of these injuries are preventable. They identified overuse injuries in young athletes as a critical issue. This means that sports-related microtraumas are repetitively using the same parts of the body, usually by overtraining. A microtrauma is a small injury to a bone, muscle, tendon, or ligament. So, when kids in these sports get a microtrauma, have them take it easy, especially in the area of the microtrauma. Resting that area until healing has taken place will create more fun and a longer time playing sports in the near future!

Concussion Care

Concussion care should top every youth sports playbook. Being struck by another person or object is a leading cause of unintentional injury for teens and young adults aged 15-24. And sports-related concussions are a significant contributor. Most concussions occur during games, not practices. Few result in loss of consciousness.

If your child gets hit on the head, do not assume it is a minor ordeal. Concussions are very serious and always require medical attention. Signs and symptoms of concussion include confusion, forgetfulness, glassy eyes, disorientation, clumsiness or poor balance, slowed speech, and changes in mood, behavior or personality.

Following a concussion, athletes of all ages are advised to undergo a series of steps before returning to play: rest, then light exercise and sport-specific training. Only then should they be cleared to resume contact drills.
