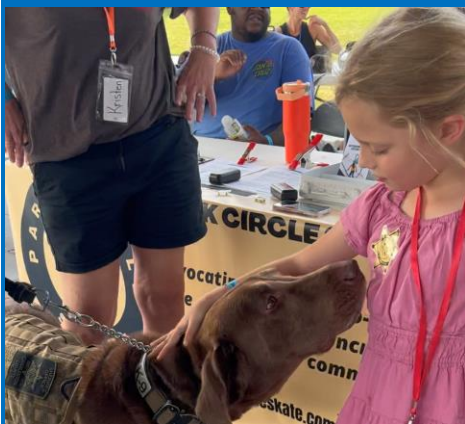

### PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

- Larcenies are occurring all over Charleston County! Please do not allow valuables to be easily accessible on your person. Keep your wallet/purse close to your person at all times.
- Auto Break-ins are still ongoing. Ensure that your vehicle doors are locked at *all times* when the vehicle is not in use with no valuable items in your vehicle, or valuables easily seen through the windows.
- Breach of Trust cases have been occurring throughout Charleston County. Please do not lend your vehicle to anyone besides those who are registered drivers of the vehicle. Family and friends, unfortunately, are the most common suspects of these cases.
- Burglaries are on the rise. Keep all the doors for your business/residence locked when not in use. Do not let any valuables be easily seen through windows (Blinds/drapes are highly recommended). Leaving the front door/porch light on
  - PRO TIP #1: Get a yard sign that states your property is protected by a security company. Even if you don't have that company (it's great to have, though) that sign is a great deterrent!
  - PRO TIP #2: Security cameras! Keep them in out of reach areas outside your home/business. Not only are they a great deterrent, but it will help Law Enforcement with identifying perpetrators.
