PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

Job Fairs are still ongoing. If you or you know someone who is in need of a job or a career, don't hesitate to attend! Here are some tips for a successful interview.

BEFORE INTERVIEW

- Research the company and interviewers
- Practice your interview answers
- Reread the job description
- Use the STAR method
 - Prepare to be asked about times in the past when you used a specific skill and use the STAR method to tell stories with a clear Situation, Task, Action and Result
- Practice answering questions with someone
- Prepare a list of references
- Be prepared with examples of your work
- Prepare smart questions for your interviewers

INTERVIEW DAY

- Plan your interview attire the night before
- Bring resume copies, a notebook and a pen
- Plan to arrive 10–15 minutes early
- Make a great first impression
- Treat everyone you encounter with respect
- Win them over with authenticity and positivity
- Respond truthfully to the questions asked
- Tie answers to your skills and accomplishments
- Keep your answers concise and focused
- Don't speak negatively about previous employers

AFTER THE INTERVIEW

- Ask about next steps
- Send a thank-you letter after the interview
