Good morning Joe,

Thank you for letting us take so long to get this back to you - due to the holiday, finding the time to sit down and run the numbers was a near impossibility!

Below are the prices for the options you laid out. For option 1, we attempted to account for all the price increases/inflation we have experienced over the last 2 years, as well as trying to make sure (as best we can) that we would not need to adjust the price again for the remaining contract extensions.

We also included an Option 4 - Year Round Service. The difficulty of retaining trained and certified staff that are available to work as early as March and as late as October (as in Option 3) creates an excess cost. We wanted to show that covering the beach year-round, while still a higher price, is much more economical. The winter months would be the same 1 person/1 vehicle staffing model as in October and March of Option 3.

Option 1: Maintain Current Level of Service - **\$209,580**

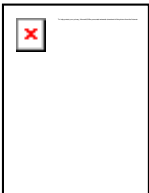
Option 2: Add 2 staff/2 vehicles - **\$239,066**

Option 3: Add March and October - **\$269,072**

Option 4: Year Service - **\$293,832**

Gentlemen,

For pricing purposes for 2023, let’s start with 3 options. The first is to maintain the same level of coverage that we have in 2022. The second would keep the same dates, but ensure we have at least 2 people and 2 vehicles on the beach at all times. The third option would be the same as the second, but would add 1 person/1 vehicle for the months of March and October.

For options 2 and 3, I’m not sure how you would need to do it logistically, since it would be 2 people/2 vehicles from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm, but 4 people/2 vehicles between 12:00 pm and 4:00 pm when the 2 shifts overlap.
