

TOWN OF SEABROOK ISLAND
Town Council Meeting of May 31, 2018

MINUTES

After the pledge of allegiance, Mayor Ciancio called the May 31, 2018, Special Town Council meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Councilmen Crane and Gregg, Councilwoman Finke, Town Clerk Allbritton and Town Administrator Cronin attended the meeting. Members of the Seabrook Island Utility Commission were also present. The meeting was properly posted and the requirements of the SC Freedom of Information Act were met.

Adoption of Resolutions 2018-08, 2018-09 and 2018-10 to Appoint and Commission Code Enforcement Officers for the Proper Security and General Welfare for the Town of Seabrook Island (Island Beach Services, LLC, Personnel – Jed Christoph, Tucker Hamilton and Max Hutton) – Town Administrator Cronin stated that beach patrol staffing levels have increased as of May 27th. Two employees of Island Beach Services will patrol the beach from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in one vehicle and two additional employees will patrol from noon until 8:00 p.m. in a second vehicle. The two shifts will overlap from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. to facilitate lunch breaks with uninterrupted patrols. Because of the increase in personnel needed for beach patrol, three additional employees of Island Beach Services will be sworn in as Code Enforcement Officers – Jed Christoph, Tucker Hamilton and Max Hutton. Resolutions 2018-08, 2018-09 and 2018-10, appointing each as a Code Enforcement Officer for the Town of Seabrook Island, are included in Council packets.

Councilman Gregg made a motion to adopt Resolutions 2018-08, 2018-09 and 2018-10 to appoint the three additional Code Enforcement Officers. Councilman Crane seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

Executive Session – Councilman Gregg made a motion to go into executive session to discuss the status of the Seabrook Island Utility Commission's management contract with Louis Berger/Hawthorne Services. Councilman Crane seconded the motion and the vote to approve was unanimous.

After the executive session, Council resumed their regular meeting. No decisions were made in executive session and the regular meeting was adjourned at 3:52 p.m.
