

**TOWN OF SEABROOK ISLAND  
TERMINATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY  
ISSUED JULY 13, 2021 — 3:00 PM**

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, Governor Henry McMaster declared a state of emergency in the State of South Carolina in response to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 7, 2021, Governor Henry McMaster announced termination of the state of emergency in the State of South Carolina); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, the Mayor of the Town of Seabrook Island declared a State of Emergency within the Town of Seabrook Island to support the Town's efforts to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Town Council undertook, by means of executive orders and adoption of emergency ordinances to impose mandates to control outbreaks of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, with Executive Order 2020-07 and adoption of Emergency Ordinances 2021 – 02 (repealed) and 2021 – 03 (now expired) the continuing mandates were either made voluntary or were repealed in their entirety so that the Town has no remaining mandate adopted to respond to the spread of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Emergency declared on March 17, 2020, provided for repeal of the State of Emergency by the Mayor or a Majority of Town Council; and

**WHEREAS**, members of Town Council expressed their consent to termination of the State of Emergency within the Town at a meeting of the Town's Ways and Means Committee held July 13, 2021;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, John Gregg, as Mayor of the Town of Seabrook Island, South Carolina, in consultation with the Town Council for the Town of Seabrook Island do hereby declare termination of the state of emergency, effective immediately.
